Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the HNC/D, all applicants must also have a relevant Higher Science subject at Grade B. If a specific Science subject is required, it will be listed in 'Grade Required' column in the table below. Plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School.

Applicants to BEng programmes

HNC Additional Entry Requirements: The HNC must include Engineering Maths 2. In addition to the HNC, all applicants for Year 1 entry must have Higher Maths at Grade B or the equivalent University of Glasgow Access qualification plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School.

HND Additional Entry Requirements: The HND must include Engineering Maths 3. In addition to the HND, all applicants for Year 2 entry must have Advanced Higher Maths at Grade B or the equivalent University of Glasgow Access qualification plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School.

5. Education

Applicants to Undergraduate Teaching Degree Programmes: MEduc Education with Primary Teaching Qualification, BTechEd Technological Education and MA Primary Education with Teaching Qualification (Dumfries Campus)

Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the HNC/D, all applicants must have Higher English at Grade B and National 5 Maths at Grade B (except for BA Community Development). National 5 Application of Maths will be accepted for MEduc and MA Primary Teaching (Dumfries). Successful outcome of interview. Attend and pass the UofG online Summer School.

- Applicants who meet the academic entry requirements MAY be invited for interview.
- All qualifications must be attained within 7 years of the start date of the course.

6. Accountancy and Finance

Applicants to BAcc and BFin programmes

Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the HND, all applicants must have Higher Maths at Grade B plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School.

7. Psychology and International Relations

Applicants to MA, BSc and MA (SocSci) Psychology programmes and MA (SocSci) International Relations

Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the HND, all applicants to Psychology MA or MA (SocSci) must have Higher English at Grade B. In addition to the HND, all applicants to Psychology BSc must have a Higher Science at Grade B. Applicants to Psychology (BSc, MA, and MA SocSci) must also have National 5 Maths at Grade B.

8. Law

Applicants to LLB programmes

Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the HND, all must pass LNAT test at cut-off score or better (see www.lnat.ac.uk). The cut-off score fluctuates year by year. Plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School.

9. Nursing

Additional Entry Requirements: In addition to the Applied Sciences HNC/D, applicants must have National 5 Chemistry at Grade B plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School. Successful outcome of interview.

HN Healthcare Practice students will only be considered if candidates also have two Highers at grade B or above in science subjects (Maths, Chemistry, Physics, Biology/Human Biology). If Chemistry is not one of the two science Highers candidates must hold this at National 5 grade B or above. Plus attend and pass the UofG Summer School. Successful outcome of interview.
