


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Introduction

The **Undergraduate Admissions BI/Query Data Model** allows users to access sets of information pertaining to UCAS/UTT applicants, such as the course they are applying for, current qualifications and so on.

The Undergraduate Admissions BI/Query model runs from a set of tables that are updated nightly from the live database, therefore extracted data will be at least 24 hours old. It is very important that queries are well thought out and not over-complicated so that no clashes in the use of the database tables are created.



When the model is first opened, the user is presented with the Main Window, which affords access to the model window through the grey button marked 'Model' under the 'Menu' list. The model window allows users to construct their own queries.



A Word of Warning for the use of BI/Query.

BI/Query can prove deceptively simple to use, but care must be taken to ensure you are producing the data that you expect. Try out some examples first where you know the results before submitting the query for real, and confirm that they are correct. Always try and start with simple queries, and build these up into more complex ones, checking at each stage the results are as expected.

A good understanding of the data in the database is essential to using BI/Query efficiently and correctly, and to ensuring that you obtain the correct results.



The Descriptions

The following is a list of all the tables within the data model, together with a description of each of the fields, or attributes, in the table. **Format** gives an indication of what kind of data is held in the field. **C** indicates a Character field and the number following gives the maximum length (e.g. C8 is an eight Character field). **Num** and **Float** are numeric fields. Finally, **Date** indicates an attribute that holds a date; dates should be in the form of dd/mm/yyyy.
